

## **NEW GREENWAY OPPORTUNITIES**

### **Overview**

The 2000 Greenways Plan Update planning process identified a significant public demand for more Greenways particularly in the following areas:

- The south and southeastern portions of Marion County which lack major watercourses or rail corridors available for greenway designation.
- East to west connections between major greenway corridors such as Eagle Creek, the Monon Rail Trail, the Central Canal Towpath, Fall Creek and White River.
- Along major thoroughfares within densely developed residential and commercial areas.

The Indianapolis Greenways Plan should be open to amendment during the five-year interval between updates. New Greenway opportunities to be considered for inclusion in the Indianapolis Greenways Plan include the following:

- Regional Bike and Pedestrian Plan
- Marion County Bike Route System
- Michigan Road Corridor/ Interurban Corridor
- Major Stream tributaries such as Brookside Creek, Little Buck Creek, Little Eagle Creek, Falcon Creek
- Pike Township Living Links Plan
- Utility Corridors
- Inactive Rail Corridors such as the Penn Central
